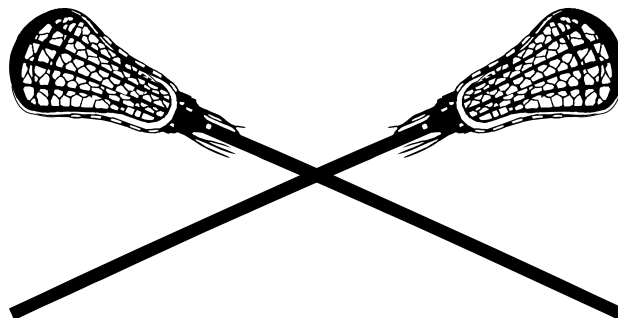


Connor McKemey
